

SCHEDULE 2: PRACTICAL, CLINICAL AND PROFESSIONAL COURSES

1 PURPOSE

This Schedule forms part of the Academic Progression Policy and lists courses for which there are additional requirements for successful study. These requirements are determined with reference to standards for accreditation or endorsement with external professional bodies and are applicable for the full duration of the course. Courses listed on Schedule 2 may have additional course-specific inherent requirements and/or other compulsory course requirements.
