

SCHEDULE 2: PRACTICAL, CLINICAL AND PROFESSIONAL COURSES

1 PURPOSE

This Schedule supports implementation of the Academic Progression [Policy](#) (in effect from Session 1 2017). This Schedule is reviewed annually and lists the courses commencing in the following year to the last review date.

Schedule 2 lists courses for which there are additional requirements for successful study. These requirements are determined with reference to standards for accreditation or endorsement with external professional bodies and are applicable for the full duration of the course. Courses listed on Schedule 2 may have additional course-specific inherent requirements and/or other compulsory course requirements. These requirements will be published in the Macquarie University Handbook. Inability to meet these requirements may result in a withdrawal of offer of admission. Courses on schedule 2 may also be subject to more rigorous academic progression requirements.
