The degree is conferred as a way of honouring an exceptional achievement or contribution in relation to a particular field or discipline, and/or to the University and society. Honorary awards are identified by the inclusion of 'Hon' in the post-nominals.

All staff are welcome to submit nominations for consideration by the Honorary Awards Committee. You should discuss your nomination with your Head of Department or Executive Dean, who will submit it on your behalf. We also recommend that you read the <u>Honorary Degree Policy</u> before submitting your nomination.
